### Bulletins:

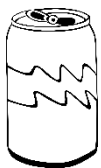

### Mark Luckey, Executive Director/Every Child Ministries

June 16, 2020: The pandemic has made ECM's ministry work more difficult. In many African countries the lockdown is a lot more severe than we have experienced. For example in Ghana, if you are moving around without having a mask or not in possession of hand sanitizer, you are put in jail! In addition, public transportation, which is most people's only form of transportation, has been shut down. Pray for Mark as he is getting ready to set annual goals and visions during this unprecedented time. Pray also for Mark and his wife Stacey as their house has some added stressors. They have two young, adopted children of their own. Their son in the Air Force got stationed in Kuwait for seven months. Since COVID-19 hit, their daughter-in-law and her two young children have been living with them. Although Mark and Stacey get a short two week reprieve when they move in with her parents, they return for two more months! Pray also for ECM's fundraiser on September 12. In lieu of their traditional October banquet, they are having a pig roast/virtual fundraiser.
