Returnable Can Collection:



June 19, 2020: I have been asked to move to Moresby, our capital city, for a few months to fill in as the government rep/guesthouse manager. I am not sure what all this means, but I am excited about learning a new role, and looking forward to the people I will meet as I serve there. I plan to go down late July.

July 13, 2020: Just wanted to write and let you know my plans have changed. This is due to the quarantine restrictions of the current Gov Rep's home country. They would need to spend a total of 6 weeks of 3-1/2 months in isolation. Therefore they made the reasonable decision to stay in PNG. However I still have a ticket that needs to be used. I am considering going for a break now or maybe later with a friend. I will be planning to fill in as the supply manager until the previous one and his family can get back to PNG. They are hoping to be back sometime in September. After that I am not sure what God has planned for me. I appreciate your prayer regarding the needs I had shared focusing on home assignment which I still hope to take in February.

Prayer/Praise:

- Thankful for His continued provision. I really have been thankful for each financial gift when so many are feeling the economic impact related to COVID 19.
- For friends here in PNG who really have become like family.
- Great relationships with my citizen coworkers.
- The means to host folks for meals and the mutual encouragement that it offers.

- That I grow to know the Love of God...that it would permeate my life. Please pray that I wouldn't have just an intellectual relationship but that I would know God as a loving Daddy.

- For my home assignment...I am hoping to come back February 2021.
- For the airfare...about \$2000 USD
- For the provision of a car or the funds to buy one for the time I will be home. (\$3000-\$5000)
