July 12, 2020: Thank you for your continued prayers and support in the midst of a strange time. We are praying for protection, peace, and joy for you today and as you think about the future!

I would like to share an urgent prayer request, and a few updates below. A little while ago, my bankcard expired and I have been without a card for a little under a month. The new card has been sent to my parents, but mail across continents has been extremely

unreliable. My mom will be mailing it within the US to a colleague who will be able to hand deliver it, but it needs to get there between the 19th and 30th of July in order to for it to make its way to Hungary, assuming that these colleagues will also be allowed back into Hungary. Please join us in praying that my bankcard would arrive during this window, without complications. Please also pray for many of our colleagues who are in the U.S. right now, who will need to be back in time for school! A quick update since last time:

- I have been meeting with the middle school girls each week at a park. Our focus has been learning and practicing various Bible study methods, while also spending time connecting (in person!) with each other. The meetings have been very encouraging. The first week we had ten girls! Since then the numbers have dwindled a bit as borders have opened up, and they've headed to other countries for the summer, but there are still girls who come, and they are eager to learn! Please pray that the middle school girls would take more initiative to dig deeper as they study God's word... both in our times together and at home as well!
- Chris is taking Hungarian lessons during these months of "extra" time, and he is making great progress. He's also building relationships with the people in his class, and thinking about how to make Gospel connections with them. Please pray for Chris to make the most of every opportunity to share the Gospel with his actions and words!
