Their youth leader contacted us to see if there were any projects that they could do for us. We jumped at the opportunity. Yesterday was there first day and they are doing a great job. It is quite a job for Vicky as she is feeding all 30 of them. She does have another gal helping. Pray for safety as they work and travel. In the evening they are doing a Bible school close to Kalamazoo. We praise the Lord for providing the materials for the projects. I will also be doing some training with them so that we can present the closing for the VBS Friday evening.

Next Monday I have surgery on my left knee. It isn't anything much and will be outpatient. Pray for a quick recovery and that this will fix things. It keeps locking up and also threatens to put me on the ground. So far I have not fallen but sometimes it is close.

In April our internet went down. When I reported it I was told that an osprey had built a nest on the tower which prevents them from being able to replace faulty equipment. They said that they have to wait for the bird to leave before they can fix it. They said that won't be until late summer or fall. So that has limited what we can do. I started making some short videos to share with churches that are doing online things with their

kids. Making the videos was the easy part. Trying to get them uploaded has been a nightmare. I have checked with every internet provider I know of and none of them can provide service here.
