IBC Missions Update

Dr. Bob & Shirley Cropsey/ABWE



August 4, 2020: Shirley had her hip replaced over a month ago at CCH with some complications with her heart and needing to be readmitted for a few days. She is doing OK now and back on her regular pain meds which has helped a lot. She is up and walking pretty normally taking walks daily walking further each day.

We have been working with our surgeons coming and going from Togo trying to be on those rare flights between Togo and the States. Two of our career surgeons and families are now home on their first furloughs and have completed their mandatory 2 week quarantines. By God's goodness, we have two young surgeons who have finally made it back to Togo after waiting for up to two months for a special flight back to Togo.

We have another surgeon family who leaves for one year next Sunday to help out in our southern hospital. Pray that his flight doesn't cancel at the last minute.

I have been doing a number of Zoom calls with our teams in Togo, having just had another call with both teams and short term docs here stateside last Saturday AM. Otherwise, it has been nice to begin setting up meetings for later this fall and on into the winter and spring of 2021. Zoom calls or Face time calls with a number of potential short term and career folks has replaced driving and flying for the mean time. A team of regular short term physicians have joined me in setting up a Medical Friends of Togo website and newsletter. We just published out first quarterly newsletter for physicians to keep them up to date on upcoming opportunities for serving with us in our mission hospitals. We also have numerous projects, like our \$10M Vision 20/20 Project, for doubling the size of our southern hospital to a 100 bed hospital in southern Togo as we prepare for setting up a surgical residency program there in 2022 by His grace. So as you can imagine, we are involved in fund raising as well as recruiting more career physicians to staff our hospital. At this moment, we have two more young surgeon families winding up their support effort to be in language school the end of 2020 in France with a third surgeon family about to join them. We also have a number of short term family practice families preparing to come for two year fellowships to both of our hospitals in Togo.

God has given us a special opportunity on having a book written about our adventures of being missionaries in Togo that will hopefully be published sometime in the next month or so which we will gladly share with you when it is ready! We are so grateful for your faithfulness in praying and supporting us, Bob
