COVID19 guidelines have kept us home in MI since March, we didn't make it to PNG last month, and we were just waiting to hear what the next step would be. GOOD NEWS....WE HAVE OUR NEXT STEP!!! It is finally GO time!! At this moment, we can't really divulge all of the details. BUT we can tell you this much: If all goes according to plan, we will be on a flight to Papua New Guinea by the end of this month!!!

It feels so surreal! You guys know how long we've been working toward and waiting for this!! The last few weeks have been an absolute flurry of preparations. Packing hasn't been easy. As of yesterday, all of our totes that we're bringing with us in a few weeks are packed, weighed, locked and ready to put on the plane. Tomorrow we will officially move out of our house. We will stay with family until August 19th when we will board a plane to CA to see Grace's family before we leave.

At the end of this month we will board our flight and begin the long trek to PNG!!
