August 10, 2020: Thank you for praying! Just three days ago I posted an update on the passport application process. At that time it had been 16 weeks with no noticeable progress on my passport. Today I got a phone call from the passport agency saying my passport should be issued by the end of today and should expect it in the mail in the next week! That means that in the next couple weeks, I should be able to resume the much-needed next phase of paperwork. Thank you for praying with me. I'm excited to see God continue to work in preparing to move to Papua New Guinea, Lord willing, in January!

August 22, 2020: It has been awhile since I last posted a flag to represent progress in support raising...so check it out!! Currently, I am just over 55% monthly support! In the past few weeks since I have been back on the road, a couple more churches and a few individuals expressed a desire to join my ministry partnership team, so that is a HUGE praise! Praise the Lord!! Thank you to everyone who has helped to make this possible, whether through personally joining my financial support team, through hosting me, connecting me



with others, helping to organize speaking engagements, and for praying with and for me! Each of you have been a huge blessing! What now? Please be praying with me that by October, we can fill in at least another 16 of these circles (each circles represents \$50 monthly support). That would increase it to 75% which is needed before getting flight tickets. And Lord willing, reach 100% before moving to Papua New Guinea in January 2021! It's just a few months away. I am excited, yet know a lot needs to happen between now and then.
