

Promises Here and Now

All Scriptures are from the New American Standard Version (1977) unless otherwise indicated.

2 Samuel 7:11b ... and I will give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also declares to you that the LORD will make a house for you.

2 Samuel 8:1 Now after this it came about that David defeated the Philistines and subdued them; and David took control of the chief city from the hand of the Philistines.

2 Samuel 8:2 He defeated Moab, and measured them with the line, making them lie down on the ground; and he measured two lines to put to death and one full line to keep alive. And the Moabites became servants to David, bringing tribute.

Numbers 24:17b “I see him, but not now; I behold him, but not near; A star shall come forth from Jacob, A scepter shall rise from Israel, And shall crush through the forehead of Moab, And tear down all the sons of Sheth.

2 Samuel 8:3 Then David defeated Hadadezer, the son of Rehob king of Zobah, as he went to restore his rule at the River.

Genesis 15:18 On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, “To your descendants I have given this land,

2 Samuel 8:4 David captured from him 1,700 horsemen and 20,000 foot soldiers; and David hamstringed the chariot horses, but reserved *enough* of them for 100 chariots.

Deuteronomy 17:16 “Moreover, he shall not multiply horses for himself, nor shall he cause the people to return to Egypt to multiply horses, since the LORD has said to you, ‘You shall never again return that way.’”

2 Samuel 8:5-6 When the Arameans of Damascus came to help Hadadezer, king of Zobah, David killed 22,000 Arameans. **6** Then David put garrisons among the Arameans of Damascus, and the Arameans became servants to David, bringing tribute. And the LORD helped David wherever he went.

2 Samuel 8:7-12 David took the shields of gold which were carried by the servants of Hadadezer and brought them to Jerusalem. **8** From Bethah and from Berothai, cities of Hadadezer, King David took a very large amount of bronze. **9** Now when Toi king of Hamath heard that David had defeated all the army of Hadadezer, **10** Toi sent Joram his son to King David to greet him and bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer and defeated him; for Hadadezer had been at war with Toi. And *Joram* brought with him articles of silver, of gold and of bronze. **11** King David also dedicated these to the LORD, with the silver and gold that he had dedicated from all the nations which he had subdued: **12** from Aram and Moab and the sons of Ammon and the Philistines and Amalek, and from the spoil of Hadadezer, son of Rehob, king of Zobah.

1 Chronicles 22:14 “Now behold, with great pains I have prepared for the house of the LORD 100,000 talents of gold and 1,000,000 talents of silver, and bronze and iron beyond weight, for they are in great quantity; also timber and stone I have prepared, and you may add to them.

2 Samuel 8:14 ... And the LORD helped David wherever he went.

1 Corinthians 15:57 but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world — our faith.

Romans 8:37 But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.

2 Samuel 7:9b ... and I will make you a great name, like the names of the great men who are on the earth.

2 Samuel 8:13 So David made a name *for himself* when he returned from killing 18,000 Arameans in the Valley of Salt.

Revelation 3:12 'He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name.

2 Samuel 7:10-11a "I will also appoint a place for My people Israel and will plant them, that they may live in their own place and not be disturbed again, nor will the wicked afflict them any more as formerly, 11 even from the day that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel;

1 Samuel 2:12 Now the sons of Eli were worthless men; they did not know the LORD

1 Samuel 8:3 His sons, however, did not walk in his ways, but turned aside after dishonest gain and took bribes and perverted justice.

2 Samuel 8:15 So David reigned over all Israel; and David administered justice and righteousness for all his people.

Isaiah 9:7 There will be no end to the increase of *His* government or of peace, On the throne of David and over his kingdom, To establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness From then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this.

1 Kings 10:9b "Blessed be the LORD your God who delighted in you to set you on the throne of Israel; because the LORD loved Israel forever, therefore He made you king, to do justice and righteousness."

2 Samuel 8:16-18 Joab the son of Zeruiah *was* over the army, and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud *was* recorder. **17** Zadok the son of Ahitub and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar *were* priests, and Seraiah *was* secretary. **18** Benaiah the son of Jehoiada was over the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and David's sons were chief ministers.

Matthew 5:25 "Make friends quickly with your opponent at law while you are with him on the way, so that your opponent may not hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the officer, and you be thrown into prison.
