IBC Missions Update

August 20, 2020: Back in March we quickly learned that our normal outreach to families through home visits, school visits, Bible clubs and the like just wasn't going to happen. So we asked the simple but dangerous question, "What do you actually need?" It was at that point that we realized that what they needed was food, and that they needed it soon. So we stopped our normal activities, and put our efforts into raising funds for food and distributing that food to our kids and their families. By doing so, we met an immediate need, and at the same time continued to carry out our mission of bringing hope. Our continued mission is to bring hope to the hopeless in every situation, so that all may experience the love and grace of God. Our ultimate calling is to bring hope through service to others, and more importantly, to grow God's Kingdom through service to Him.



Pray for **sponsored children: Moses** has a brain tumor. The photo is of him when he went for his CT scan. Pray that it would not be cancerous and for any treatments needed. Pray for the funds to cover Moses' medical needs if his sponsor is not able to cover them. **Lucy** is in prison after throwing a heavy object at a young man, after which he died. Uganda staff are working with Lucy to obtain legal representation.

Susan is unmarried and pregnant. The father of the baby is the boy Lucy threw the object at. Susan's mother and sibling are in Kampala, but Susan is in Karamoja with the boy's family. They are not allowing her to return to Kampala for reasons not yet known to us. Susan's family's home and belongings were destroyed, also for reasons not yet known.

Pray for U.S. staff as they are planning **two new fundraising events**. September 12 is a Hog Roast Fundraiser to raise funds for the Next Step program which helps launch young adults successfully from sponsorship into independence. Pray for all the details to come together, that people would register, for good weather that day, and for interest in what the Next Step program accomplishes. The second fundraiser is taking place on October 10; it is a Virtual Fundraiser to replace the Indiana Banquet. Pray for God to give us ideas in the planning and for all the details to come together.



Pray for **missionaries** Sharise, Bonnie & Wayne, and Cathy. Sharise has been in the U.S. and not able to get back to her ministry in Congo. Pray that God would provide a way or show her what she should be doing while in the U.S. Bonnie & Wayne serve in Uganda, and though their rent is paid up through November, their landlord has put their home on the market to sell.
