order for us to return to Asia. We don't know why we are still in the USA, but we are trying to make the most of it. We are patiently waiting for God's timing. In the meantime what we do on a daily basis looks a lot like hard work. We have whipped our fixer upper into shape, knocking out some walls, painting a lot, redoing the kitchen, and now we begin refinishing the basement. Last month we went to Virginia and worked a lot on Kari's parent's home. We also were able to spend time with dear family friends who we miss like crazy.

It weighs heavy on our hearts every day and we can really only lay it at the Father's feet as it's completely out of our hands. We miss the Asmat people dearly and look forward to when we can land on the river and see their smiling faces!!
