September 2020: I really appreciate how you guys have been standing with me over the last several years.



I've worked in different areas here in PNG: the guest house, and our print shop. Then in April, because of COVID, I was asked to go work back in supply, where I worked before. I'm helping in integrating our new ERP (Enterprise Resource Program) system. It tracks all our sales and inventory throughout the field.

I had planned on coming home in February 2021, however, with some needs in our capital city of Moresby, the government reps needed to go back to Canada for six months to maintain their citizenship. I was asked to fill in there from April through October 2021, so it looks like I'll delaying my home assignment until at least February 2022. Thank you for being willing to help me out with that.

Life hasn't been affected too much here because of COVID. We do see some restrictions on getting supplies into the country. Currently PNG is seeing around 400 cases; in our region there may be three cases total. Cases are more focused in the capital city and around the gold mine.

When I first moved out here, I was looking for an opportunity to have a home that was able to host people. In the last two weeks, I've been able to move to a two-bedroom house with a huge living room and dining room. Out of the last 10 days, I may have had guests for five of those days. It's just a joy to be able to host people, to love on them through cooking, and serving them some yummy food that they don't have to cook themselves.

I would appreciate your continuing to pray for me:

- To walk with God in His strength.
- Mom and brother their relationship with each other and with the Lord
- Mission more people are coming back/support staff coming back
- School starting again in January
- New believers
