September 23, 2020: As of right now we are still on schedule to fly out on Sunday, September 27th. It's an absolute miracle because everyone else has had their flights cancelled. Our travel agent called us a few days ago to say that she has been making phone calls to airlines and embassies at each of our stops, and she is confident that we will make it.



Prayer requests:

- Continue to pray that no flights will be canceled! We have a total of five flights and any of them could get canceled at any time and leave us stranded.
- We need a TON of paperwork in order to board these flights and enter each country. Traveling during a global pandemic is no joke! We're doing our best to gather it all, please pray that we don't miss anything.
- Pray for our kids. This transition is hitting our older daughter, Nora, especially hard. Pray for her heart and for us as we help her through all of it.
- Due to circumstances, we have no choice but to fly the opposite way around the world to PNG. We have two 15-hour flights and three 3-4 hour flights. That's around 40 hours in the air. That's a long time for kids to be sitting in one seat. Pray that the girls do well!

- It sounds insignificant to write this, but pray for smooth flights. I (Grace) am terrified of flying and it would be the biggest blessing to get through this process without turbulent flights.
- Lastly, pray for all the family that we are leaving behind here in the states. It has proven to be such a heart wrenching goodbye process; we ask for prayers that the Lord would comfort the people we love so dearly. We do appreciate your prayers!!
