Morning Bible Study:

Beginning Sunday, November 1st at 9:30 am, we will have a Morning Bible Study for adults. Please join us in the classroom in the 300 wing at Pierce. Luman Strong will be teaching on "Redeeming the Time." *Redeeming the Time:* Time is one of the greatest gifts God has granted us as His children. We all get 24 hours in a day to live, but how we view time makes all the difference in terms of how we live during our very brief time here on Earth. Too often, too many people, Christians included, squander time, seeing it as a renewable resource. Only after certain watershed moments in life - a child's graduation, retirement, a birthday - do we realize the brevity of time, but with regrets. This Morning Bible Study session will examine "time": how God sees it, the purpose of time, and how we, as His children, should handle this precious resource. We have a gift, and our responsibility is to redeem it.

IBC Missions Update: Every Child Ministries

October 10, 2020: Every Child Ministries focuses on opportunities for education, physical needs, and spiritual growth for the children in DR Congo, Ghana, and Uganda.

At ECM's virtual (fundraiser) Banquet, Executive Director Mark Luckey shared the goals of ECM's ministries for the coming year: eliminate abuse and neglect that divides communities, ending mistreatment and restore the children and their communities. Children are abused, discriminated, and are everyday prisoners in their own homes. Children with albinism and disabilities are seen as cursed. ECM is working to educate the communities and churches about children's conditions, physical and mental disabilities, all while demonstrating God's love and sharing the Gospel of Jesus.

The National Director in **Uganda**, Brian Mukalazi, spoke briefly on behalf of his 31 staff and missionaries. Their areas of focus: albinism, disabilities, orphans, and street children. They are educating/teaching at their Hope Centers, as well as family empowerment, providing food supplies and medical needs for the children.

The National Director in **Ghana**, Edward Sekyere, spoke briefly on behalf of his 45 staff and missionaries. Their focus: street children, less privileged, albinism, orphans, child slavery, and trafficking. One of their goals for the coming year is to get a medical clinic up and running at their Haven of Hope.

Founders John & Lorella Rouster reported on the happenings in **DR Congo**. (Lorella is still active in ministry work there, as well as with a Congo Radio program.) The COVID pandemic brought about creative ways to keep the children's groups going, which involved other adults not normally involved. Staff seminars are still being done to train Sunday school teachers. Translation work of Sunday school materials, writing lessons, and printing of materials has just been completed and more are being written, translated, and printed.

Since this event was a fundraiser, their prayer request is FUNDING! ECM will be launching an on-line store from their website selling homemade items from Uganda as well as some ECM promotional merchandise.
