October 2020: It is exciting to hear how many of our Awana Clubs in South Central and South West Michigan are once again running their ministries this fall. Many are in-person with safety precautions. Others are meeting virtually through Zoom or other means, and some are working with parents to have an Awana-at-home type of ministry.

- 42 out of 85 churches that have responded to us are meeting in-person.
