Matthew 1:18a Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows. ...

Matthew 1:22 Now all this took place that what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet might be fulfilled, saying,

Matthew 1:23 “BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD, AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL,” which translated means, “GOD WITH US.”
