

January 2021: Happy New Year to you from India! It is my prayer that your new year will be blessed as you continue to keep your eyes on Jesus. Don't be discouraged by the chaos of our world. God is in control and He has things firmly in His grasp.



I am so thankful that for several months, my mom and I have enjoyed being with my sister and her husband. Covid-19 is rampant in Delhi so we have been advised not to return home right now. With mom being 97, we are taking extra precautions to keep her safe and isolated. We are tentatively schedule to return to Delhi in mid-February, but that is subject to change.

One of the good things that came out of the lockdown was the formation of the "Children for Jesus" ministry. We have two groups, one for

younger kids ages 5-12; and another for teens, ages 13-18. We have programs each Sunday afternoon and on average about 60 children participate. The advantage of using Zoom is that we are not limited by geographical location so we have children from all over India, representing several different cultures, who regularly participate. It has become apparent that there is a need for a similar program for college and career age young people, so please pray as we are in the planning stages of getting that ministry off the ground soon.

Throughout 2020 as the lockdown wore on, we heard more and more about the negative and even deadly effects that isolation was having on the senior population. Since many of my friends are in that demographic, I thought that it would be beneficial to begin a community group of senior men for chatting and sharing devotional messages from the Word. We have now started "meeting" by Zoom with great participation. Again, I am thankful to God for initiating this ministry. Please pray that those who participate will be encouraged to grow in their walk with the Lord.
