

Winter Camp: There's something special about winter camp! Kids need to be active and enjoy fun things to do. They need in-person interaction with others, even if masks and social distancing are required. They need to be assured that God loves them, and we do, too!



For kids who are struggling with hardships on a daily basis, winter at Youth Haven is a special opportunity to engage in fun indoor and outdoor activities with other **PAYEN** kids. It's good food warming them from the inside out.

It's the Gospel message giving them hope. We're grateful to provide that experience for these kids, and to teach them that God cares about everything they're going through. But we couldn't do it without you! Every deserving child comes to Youth Haven free of charge. It is only through your financial gifts that we are able to meet their needs and share God's love with them.

Youth Haven Dorms: Our dorms are an important part of creating an environment where disadvantaged children feel safe, comfortable, and have their needs met. Our Michigan dorms have served us well for many vears but are in need of several upgrades. These include:

- Adding bathrooms inside the dorms for use by the children and staff as needs arise, especially throughout the night
- Installing a new, energy-efficient heating and cooling system to help the children sleep more comfortably
- Upgrading the interior walls to drywall to create a more cozy environment and help control noise
- Covering the cement floor with new flooring
- Adding an enclosed porch area where children and staff can remove their shoes and any wet or dirty outdoor gear

• Purchasing new beds and mattresses for the kids and staff We need your help to cover the costs of these upgrades. We estimate the cost to be approximately \$75,000 per building, and we're currently working on four.
