IBC Missionary Update: Chris & Zoe Fletcher / Teach Beyond

The Eternal Weight of Glory: These winter months have been challenging. In November our high school switched over to distance learning. All restaurants, museums, and theaters closed, gatherings of over 10 people were no longer allowed, and an 8 pm curfew went into effect. Though our case numbers have decreased since November, it still feels like we'll be in this season of restrictions forever. Twice the government has extended the restrictions, and it is so easy to lose hope.

House Church: Because of the government's restrictions, we have been doing online church since November. One of the most surprising blessings of this whole time has been the gift of House Church. A core of five of us have been meeting together to share a meal, watch church, share life, pray, and play games together. This season of House Church has led to deep friendships, and celebrating living life closely with others, week to week. These dear friends are fellow missionaries, though from different missions, with huge hearts for Budapest and Hungary!

Decisions Soon: Within a month or so, we will need to be making a decision about our totalization plan. We have had some good times praying together over this, and feel the Lord asking us to trust Him with the timing. He knows our deadlines, and He will make it clear. Please pray that we would come to the right decision about where to be from June - December of this year!

Just a recap: Due to a tax agreement between Hungary and the U.S., Zoe has to leave Hungary for 6 months every 5 years. An extension can be applied for, but if it is denied, we would have to leave when we hear back about the decision. We would need to apply for the extension by March 15th. We intend to return to Hungary and ICSB in December.
