



IBC Missionary Update: John & Lorella Rouster / ECM

Lorella to Congo March 6-18: Lorella's government invitation and visa were both received in record time. On February 25, John sealed up the last of 19 tubs of Sunday school materials. They completed their full round of Covid vaccinations; however, Lorella's trip was delayed because her test results did not come in time. Her updated departure date was March 9.

Why just Lorella? Why not John? John is feeling so much better following all the work on his heart. He has more energy, and all his check-ups are good. His defibrillator has not gone off. However, if anything should go wrong in Congo, there is no help there. While doctors here have constant communication through his monitor, that would not be in effect in Congo.

How can Lorella manage alone? Because of her mobility issues, Lorella cannot walk through the airport, wait in line, etc., so she will have wheelchair assistance. On arrival in Congo, she has to get another Covid test before even entering the terminal. Just outside, some of our Congo leaders will meet her and take charge of everything from there.

Where will she stay and what will she do? Lorella is excited this year to be staying at the Handicap Center in Kinshasa. It is a guest center, restaurant, and gift shop all run by handicapped people who would otherwise find it difficult to make a living. Although she misses direct village ministry and personal contact with the children, Lorella treasures these times of praying, evaluating, and strategizing with the Congo staff.
