

## Missionary Update: Chris & Zoe Fletcher / Teach Beyond / Hungary

Our community has been hit hard by COVID. In March our school switched to digital learning, and teachers were strongly encouraged to work from home. On our last teacher work day, many people tested positive for covid. Over the next few weeks, over forty of our staff and school families tested positive. Five were hospitalized, including our elementary and middle school principal, Stephanie. On Good Friday, Stephanie passed away after many days in the hospital. This tragedy has left our community with a huge hole as we looked to Stephanie's steady, joyful, peace-filled leadership during already challenging times.

We covet your prayers for the following needs:

- Lift up her husband, Dan (also our school chaplain), and kids: Haley (freshman in college) and JT (freshman in high school).
- Wisdom for leadership; comfort for our school community as we grieve.
