IBC Missionary Update: Jezekeil Van Der Decker / Ethnos360 / PNG
5/2/21: Between last week and this week, I, along with the other eight new missionary units in my E2 (Equipping 2) class, will be hearing “area presentations” from each of the three areas/regions of PNG in which we as a mission serve in church planting.

Areas: Choosing which area to serve in is a major decision looming on the horizon, so I appreciate prayer for each of us as we are presented with the plethora of needs. I appreciate prayer for wisdom as we trust the Lord's direction and seek advice from veteran missionaries as well.

We have three “areas”: Western, Central, and Eastern Areas. Each of these areas have a variety of church planting needs besides all the support roles that also need to be filled to keep the missionaries out in the remote church planting locations.

Teams: Another major decision looming on the horizon is team formation (deciding which missionaries will team up to go into a remote location to do a church plant). Those teams then need to decide what “area” they will serve in and eventually what tribal location within that area.

Here is a quick overview of the 3 primary types of team formations:

A. Some of the locations are existing works in which the current missionaries are in need of more coworkers in the tribe to help

continue the church planting work. In this case, new missionaries may join an “existing work.”

- B. Some locations are “new” to us locations which would require whole teams (generally consisting of 3 families/units) to be formed and allocated. This would be the most typical type of team formation.
- C. Additionally, there are some locations in which we are looking at doing purposeful partnerships in which one or two missionary families would partner with some elders of an existing church plant to complement their skills and gifts in reaching into a new church planting location. This is becoming more common.
