

# PERSONAL CHALLENGES AHEAD:

- 1. After prayer and much discussion with John, Lorella feels she needs to go to Congo again in October. She has completed the revision of the curriculum, and feels she personally needs to introduce it to them and answer their questions. Her plan was to use John's pre-Covid ticket, which now seems to be a problem. Attempts to reach Ethiopian Air have been unsuccessful.
- 2. Physically, traveling can be very challenging for Lorella, but she feels she can do it.
- 3. Financially, besides the ticket issue, there will be the need to pay for:
  - transportation for the staff that will be using the curriculum.
  - lodging and food for all attending.
